



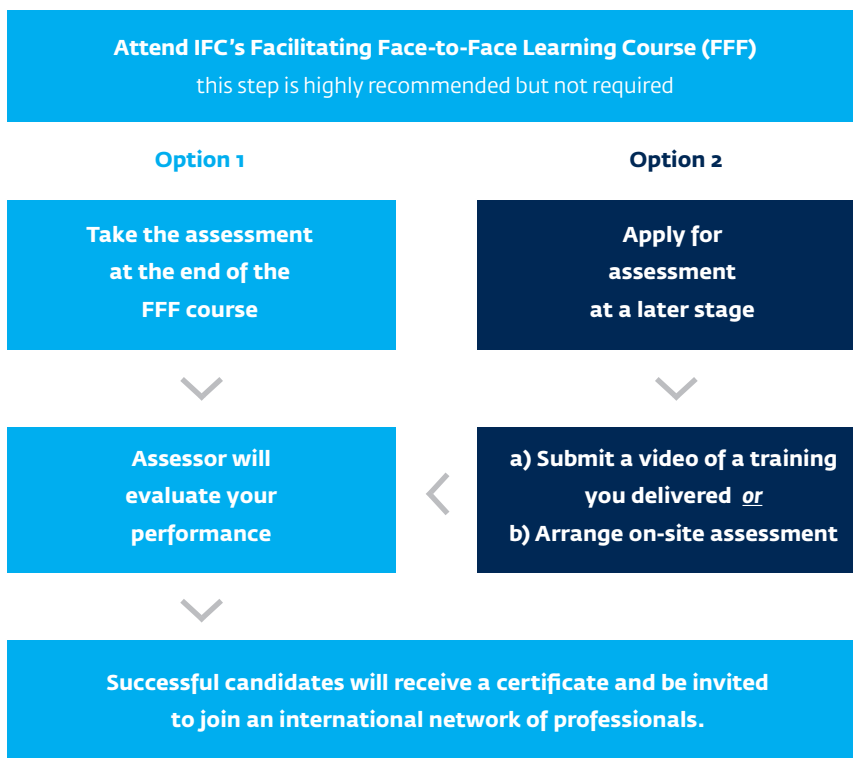
# What Makes The IFC-LPI TPMA Certification Unique?
